



NOVA01-0001 Introduction to Applied Research Online Course

This online Introduction to Applied Research course leads learners through all stages of an applied research project, from planning to the knowledge dissemination or technology transfer stage. It introduces NAIT faculty and staff to policies, business processes, and best practices for applied research and builds on real, practical examples of applied research projects from NAIT. Some of the topics covered include:

- identifying a need for research
- research ethics
- intellectual property and potential liability
- research methods
- project management
- maximizing adoption of research results
- building a research proposal

The Introduction to Applied Research course is geared towards those interested in learning more about applied research and beginning researchers, but experienced researchers may also enroll to learn about NAIT specific aspects of applied research.

The course will run entirely on-line in Moodle from September 1 through December 6, 2010. The course includes six modules with a time commitment of approximately two and a half hours per week. Participants are expected to keep to a biweekly learning schedule but may access the course at any time. Assignments are included to enhance and reinforce learning. Grading will be assigned on a complete/incomplete basis.
