INSTRUCTIONS: HOW TO APPLY FOR APPRENTICESHIP CLASSES

Apprentice Training is delivered at NAIT’s Metro, Patricia, and Souch Campuses. Eligibility for apprenticeship training is determined by Apprenticeship and Industry Training, Department of Advanced Education. If you are eligible for training, you must contact the Registrar’s Office to enroll. Acceptance will be on a first come first served basis. **Full payment is required at time of enrollment. Apprentice will be dropped from class if full payment is not received.**

Approximately one month prior to class start date you may request that your name be placed on a wait list.
