1.0 Purpose

To support the promotion of a clean air environment, NAIT does not permit smoking on NAIT's property, or within its buildings and vehicles.

2.0 Parameters

2.1 Students, faculty, staff, the public and visitors shall be made aware of NAIT's smoke free campus and property through the following:

- a) Prominent non-smoking signage will be displayed on NAIT's campuses and in its vehicles, consistent with Provincial legislation.
- b) NAIT's website.
- c) Various publications, including but not limited to program calendars, student handbooks, and employee information.

2.2 Enforcement measures for those who are observed smoking on NAIT's property or in its vehicles include, but are not limited to the following:

- a) Redirection and warning(s).
- b) Fine(s) in accordance with Provincial legislation.
- c) Possible disciplinary action upon consistent breach of this Guideline.

- 2.3** Programs will be offered to assist and encourage NAIT constituents who wish to cease smoking or reduce tobacco consumption, and the Institute will provide educational awareness.
- 2.4** Pipe ceremonies and smudge events within the Encana Aboriginal Student Centre or other approved locations are ceremonial in nature, and therefore do not fall within the scope of this Guideline.
