PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program is not intended as entry level for individuals who have not previously entered the profession. Students may have the option of a hands-on practical experience in a Radiology department of a participating clinical site(s).

The Medical Radiological Technology Review Program will be delivered online using WebCT as the learning management system. Courses will also be offered individually.

NAIT will work with the student to find a suitable clinical placement.
