Guidelines

It is essential that the applicant investigating the Veterinary Medical Assistant Program has a clear understanding of the educational program as well as the responsibilities of Veterinary Medical Assistant professionals. This questionnaire allows you to detail how you came to the decision that you are serious about becoming a member of this profession. Include as much relevant information as possible using ONLY this form and complete all sections.

Please submit a typed Career Investigation Report; handwritten submissions will be rejected. Once you have completed the report, you must send it to the Registrar's Office, along with your official transcripts, to be added to your admissions file. Applications to the program will not be considered for admission until all required supporting documentation has been received in the Registrars' Office, **no later than August 12th**.

You can submit your Career Investigation Report by uploading a saved copy through the My NAIT Portal. For detailed instructions on how to submit your Career Investigation Report online, please visit www.nait.ca/careerinvestigation. In this case you do not need to sign the last page of the form. In order to prepare your career investigation report, the following activities are suggested.

- 1. Program information sessions at NAIT:
 - Check the website at <u>www.nait.ca/infosessions.htm</u> for information on when they are offered.
- 2. Tour a Veterinary clinic:
 - Spend at least one half day in a veterinary clinic or related veterinary business.
- 3. Others:
 - Attend NAIT Open House in the fall.
 - Attend a local career fair. Meet with a career/guidance counselor. Visit related facilities and specialized practices.
