

Automobile Repair Manuals & Resources

The NAIT Library carries print, audiovisual, CD-ROM and online automobile repair material. These include:

- Shop manuals published by automotive manufacturers and manuals produced by Chilton's or Haynes
- Books, audiovisual materials (DVD and video recordings) and web sites on topics such as brakes or electronic ignition systems
- Electronic resources such as Alldata Online

Locating Resources

To start searching for automobile repair manuals in [NAITCat](#), choose **Quick Search**, type in specific keyword(s) that describe the information you need e.g. **ford tempo** (both words must be in the record).

For general automotive repair materials try **auto? repair**.

Then click on **Search**.

Important Tip: Do not use the date in your search - this does not work well for automotive manuals because one catalogue record often describes the manuals for several years.
